Placer Repertory Theater is pleased to announce the launch of the 2021 Collaboration LAB season on January 28 with the theme "New..." and featuring videos and discussion of Larissa Fasthorse (recent MacArthur Genius Grant recipient for playwrighting) and the Maidu Independent Theater of Auburn, California. Collaboration LAB is the FREE monthly open stage / open mic for the arts, culture and humanities via Zoom, on the last Thursday of each month at 7 p.m. (Pacific), January through October 2021. Participants register in advance via email (boxoffice@placerrep.org) for a presentation slot, and may try out new material, share a new work, hone their performance or presentation skills, seek collaborators, market themselves or their group, and may choose to receive feedback from attendees. From actors, singer/songwriters and filmmakers, to visual artists, stand-up comedians, writers, crafters and historical researchers, Placer County creatives come together to incubate new works and ideas in an open and supportive atmosphere.

The line-up of LIVE performers and presenters for January 28, 2021 includes Placer County locals, such as singer/songwriter Ryan Gerberding who will share a new song and Anne Merino, author of the novel Hawkesmoor who will perform a reading, Board Secretary of the Arts Council of Placer County, Twiana Armstrong-Bryant, who will share ACPC upcoming programs and events, and Kevin Foster, who will perform a monologue. Sanjay R. Singhal, an architect and author in Chicago will perform a reading, as will the San Francisco performance artist and poet, Natalie Farrell, while Orangevale's Jodi Serrano and Elk Grove's Eric Piotrowski plan to sing a duet. And writer/actor Kate Brolan from the Sacramento area will share her acting talents. Creatives who wish to join in the discussion and nonparticipating general audience members are welcome. A Rocklin resident with an MFA in Dramatic Arts and an MS in Business Management & Leadership, this critically acclaimed professional director/playwright also plays the role of Producing Artistic Director for Placer Repertory Theater. Previously, the artistic director for two San Francisco theater companies, her performing arts background includes international tours as an actor/singer/dancer, and director/playwright for national and international touring productions with renown performing artists, such as Brenda Wong Aoki, and companies like Dell'Arte International. As an educator, she has instructed and directed at UC Davis, University of San Francisco, Shawnee State University and other educational institutions.

Projects on which Forsyth worked have received Dramalogue Awards, Critics Circle Awards, Indy Award: Best Spoken Word Album, as well as numerous grants from the NEA, NEH, CAC and corporations. She is a member of the professional organizations: The Dramatists Guild, The Association for Theatre in Higher Education (ATHE) and NNPN/New Play Exchange. In the Sacramento area, she directed the production and mentored the playwright for the world premiere of Jane Austen's Northanger Abbey at Sacramento Theatre Company in 2019, and most recently directed and wrote episodes of Placer Rep's Sherlock Holmes: Domestic Mysteries series, as well as co-authored and directed My Jekyll & Hyde starring Ryan Gerberding.



RYAN GERBERDING - CO-HOST, Collaboration LAB

Ryan Gerberding is an actor from Rocklin, CA. He is very proud to be a founding company member and Digital Media Director for Placer Repertory Theatre. Ryan studied at University of California, Davis, where he earned his bachelor's degree in Theatre and Dance. There, he performed in numerous plays and musicals, including *Urinetown the Musical, Lungs, Mr. Burns: A Post Electric Play*, and *Gospel According to the First Squad*. He also directed multiple shows for Studio 301, a student-run theatre club at UC Davis, including *The Pillowman, Swimmers*, and *Dogfight*. After graduating from college, he has performed in numerous productions in the Sacramento

area, including Amélie the Musical, Shakespeare in Love and The Rocky Horror Show with Green Valley Theatre, and Small Mouth Sounds with Big Idea Theatre. Currently, he teaches youth classes for Sacramento Theatre Company and may be seen in episodes of Placer Rep's Sherlock Holmes: Domestic Mysteries series episodes on YouTube, for which he is on the writing and directing team, as well as performing duties as the digital editor, or in his solo show, My Jekyll & Hyde, currently previewing throughout the greater Sacramento area.

Kevin Foster is a Rocklin local and Sacramento area native, excited to work at Placer Repertory as Outreach Director and in various other capacities. He began training in acting at UC Davis whilst earning his B.A. in Music Performance. SANJAY R. SINGHAL - Author, Architect



Born in India, Sanjay emigrated to the United States at the tender age of three, living and travelling across the country in places as varied and as unique as his own persona. Additionally, Sanjay has travelled extensively abroad, and has lived, at times, in both Paris and in Rome, and is currently writing about his journeys there.



ANNE MERINO – Novelist, Screenwriter, Adjunct Faculty, Artistic Director of Placer Theatre Ballet

Merino began her career dancing for notable companies such as American Ballet Theatre and the London Festival Ballet and is currently the artistic director of Placer Theatre Ballet. A prolific choreographer, she won the Vanguard Award for Choreography. Merino's traditional theatrical training was received at Chicago's Goodman Theatre, Second City with Del Close and John Belushi and later trained under Alan Rickman at the British American Drama Academy. As an actress, Ms. Merino performed with The Groundlings and Tim Robbins' The Actors' Gang, is on the Theater department faculty at William Jessup University. Her screenplay, A Season

for Wolves, recently won the Critics' Choice award at the Madras Film Festival.

Natalie Farrell is a singer, actress, poet, producer, and model working and living in San Francisco and Los Angeles, who specialized in devised theatre as part of her M.A. at UC Santa Cruz.
