Taking place from 1905 to 1908, this story chronicles the town's struggle to maintain its prominence in the face of the never-ending march of progress. The six actors perform a variety of characters from a script rich with local historical references, to bring this love letter to Rocklin CA to life.*

Rocklin Roundhouse. "(He) has had large experience in railroading, having held a similar position at Salt Lake and Sacramento. He knows what a good day's work is and

consequently has the good will of the men under him." -Placer

T. J. Wilson: Right-of-way man for S.P. and Timmins's manager. A company

man through and through. Has a very practical view of the world.

Maria Aguilar: Age 20-40. Daughter of a ranching family. Born in Spain, the

family made their way to Rocklin by way of Hawaii. Has split

loyalties.

<u>Joni Wirkkala</u>: (Pronounced *Yo*-nee) Lower level manager at the roundhouse and

Timmins's right hand man. Has great respect and trust for

Timmins. Considers himself a realist.

<u>John George Sweeney:</u> President of the Board of Trustees (City Council), essentially the

mayor of Rocklin. First came to Rocklin in 1870 and found work as a barkeeper, but his entrepreneurial spirit allowed him to move

up in society.

Isidore L. Levison: Chairman of the Board of Trustees. A native of Prussia and a

member of the mercantile and banking firm of Levison and Co.

Mr. Burch: A board member. Young and naive.

Mr. Pockman: A board member. Practical.

J.B. Garity: A worker at the Rocklin roundhouse who is transferred to

Roseville. Originally from rural Ireland.
