Director/Adapter Notes

A valiant effort by company members has brought great joy as we deeply explore the theories, system, tools and techniques of Stanislavsky in Studium-Practicum, Placer Rep's professional growth program. Through the workshop

process, we apply our new knowledge and skills to Anton Chekhov's Uncle Vanya as we work toward subject matter mastery.

Uncle Vanya was first performed in 1899 by his Moscow Art Theatre where he employed his evolving theories & Sc techniques, yet this play remains relevant and relatable to this day.

Comedic love triangles, existential angst, archetypal characters, a dysfunctional family, concern about status, money, the environment, a midlife crisis and too much vodka. We all have felt the angst of wanting but not achieving, holding onto our dignity or our dreams by our fingernails even as we sense the

inevitable slide downward to compromise or failure. *Uncle Vanya* is dark and tense at times, yet this play is rich with comedy of the human condition.

THE CAST



MATTHEW D. HEYER—Uncle Vanya (Ivan Voynitzky) BFA in Theatre, University of Louisiana at Lafavette, Matthew has won two Irene Rvan awards: for ensemble work and for his performance as Elliot in *Completeness*. His favorite mainstage productions include Charles in As You Like It, Thomas Putnam in The Crucible, and Shakespeare in The Bard on Broadway. Matt performs duties as a Dialect Coach for Placer Rep, and as an actor for Placer Rep in 2021, Matthew played the characters George and Milo in From the Mind of Scott Charles, and the title role in An Evening with Sherlock Holmes as well as Mr. Elliot in The Jane Austen Soiree. In 2022, he performed with Placer Rep in the ensemble show, Haunting History, and was nominated for two Broadway World Awards, including his ten performances for Placer Rep's 2022 monthly show, Rifts in Time.

Arie is an early career actor with a BS in Computer Science, BS in Mathematics, and a minor in Psychology. Outside of his acting career, Arie works as a software engineer. Most notably they worked as a makeup designer for a collaboration piece between Cal-State Long Beach and the Long Beach Opera, *The Penal Colony*. As a performer, Kyla starred in two independent films and enjoys playing the roles of antagonists like Mr. Small in Placer Rep's production of Sherlock Holmes Sign of the Four, and Miss Henrietta Musgrove in Placer Rep's The Jane Austen Soiree in 2021. Kyla joined Placer Rep as a company member in 2023, and is engaged in the Studium-Practicum professional growth program expanding her knowledge and craft. They are also the senior facilitator for Placer Rep's VAPA Academy of Colfax.



RONNIE DUSKA FOWLER — Yelena, the Professor's wife Ronnie Duska Fowler studied at Cosumnes River College, where she performed in Arcadia and Midsummer Night's Dream, and she performed in The Laramie Project at Sacramento City College. She has been seen on the stages of Big Idea Theater in the Rover, in several productions at Freefall Stage and Theatre in the Heights where she performed in several Shakespeare plays and Blithe Spirit. More recently, she played Ann Deever in All My Sons at The Stage at Burke Junction. For Placer Repertory Theater, Ronnie performed professional readings for the masterclass "The Writer's Workshop," studies with the professional growth program Studium-Practicum and plays the key role of Yelena in Uncle Vanya this September.



CLOUD ADAMS—Prof. Aleksandr Serebryakov Cloud's initial foray into acting began early as the lead performer in theatrical works during his primary and secondary education. After 10 years of military service, during which he entertained soldiers when off duty. Cloud left the military and sought a college degree. Upon graduation from Sacramento State University with a B.S. in Judaism Theology, Cloud became quite serious about his acting career. Cloud's more recent works include the character George Spelvin in The Actor's Nightmare by Christopher Durang, Apollo Host in Buddy: The Buddy Holly Story by Alan Janes, and performed in the film "In Broad Daylight." He produces digital shorts on YouTube and Switch. Cloud also participates in Placer Rep's Studium-Practicum professional growth program.

She is a member of the Dramatists Guild and Stage Directors & Choreographers union.



CRAIG DUNLAP — **Ilia Telegin/Accompaniment.** Well known on the Sacramento Region stages as a musician / singer / song-writer, Craig Dunlap joins Placer Rep for his first professional acting role, and his bravery in taking on this chillenge is applauded. He was first discovered at Placer Rep's Collaboration LAB (incubation, networking & an open stage). Craig plays Telegin, Eastern European folk music and acoustic sound cues within the play.
