For 2024, Placer Rep won *Best Live Theatrical Group* and *Best Unique Business* in the Roseville Press Tribune. Nominated for eight Rocklin Placer Herald and four Roseville Press Tribune awards, Placer Rep won two awards, placed second for seven awards and third for two awards.
